2020 Rosé of Pinot Noir

THE VINEYARDS The blocks our winemaker's chose for our Rosé of Pinot Noir included clones 114 and the Swan clone block from our Lange Estate vineyards, augmented by Freedom Hill's exceptional Wyatt Block which is planted to Wädenswil.

VINIFICATION Our 2020 Rosé, like all previous iterations, is grown and vinified for the production of a rosé wine, as opposed to the Saignée method. The lots were crushed and remained on skins for roughly 48 hours, pressed gently, settled in stainless steel tanks, then racked to French oak puncheons, concrete vessels, and stainless steel. Individual lots were fermented with a variety of proprietary yeasts, which contributes to this wine's complexity.

THE VINTAGE "Springtime was warm and perhaps a bit early, with inclement weather rolling in at bloom. This precipitated a poorer-than-average fruit set in our vineyards which resulted in lower yields. The growing season was moderately warm, without major heat spikes and harvest occurred in the normal time frame with good Brix levels, TA and pH balance, and, ultimately moderate to slightly lower than normal alcohol levels." — Executive Winemaker, Don Lange
