### VINIFICATION

Crafted entirely from certified sustainably grown fruit from our high-elevation Dundee Hills estate, carefully selected blocks are intentionally farmed for rosé from budbreak to harvest. After reaching optimal ripeness balance, the Pinot Noir is gently harvested in the early morning hours under cold conditions and gently tumbled in the press to maintain a vibrant hue and maximize high-toned aromatics. Freshly pressed juice undergoes fermentation in neutral French oak barrels and concrete tanks with carefully selected yeast strains. Finished wines are aged sur lie to enhance mouthfeel and texture before final blending and bottling.

### THE VINTAGE

"The 2025 growing season proved to be a compact one, starting with early budbreak in April and a relatively fast bloom period in early June, which set the tone for the following 100 days. After some initial heat in June, the season stabilized with warm, dry days and nights in July and August promoting steady vegetative growth until veraison. Elevated temperatures in late August accelerated the season, resulting in a narrow picking window. The 2025 growing season ultimately presented fruit with slightly smaller berry and cluster size than average leading to great concentration and depth in the resultant wines." — Jesse Lange

### TASTING NOTES

Showcasing the full range of the varietal, the gorgeous color of this rosé is illuminant and striking in the glass. This wine delivers high-toned rose-hip aromatics before a cascade of candied strawberry, guava, and blood-orange fruit notes on the palate this wine finishes with well-rounded mouthwatering acidity and a subtle creamy almond undertone.
