The Story

Don and Wendy Lange founded the winery and estate vineyard in 1987 with an inaugural vintage that included small-lot bottlings of pinot noir, chardonnay and pinot gris. Since those early days, they have built the winery, vineyards, and tasting room brick by brick, bottle by bottle to where we are today.

Jesse officially joined on as winemaker back in 2004 after formal training at Lincoln University in New Zealand and two years refining his craft at Santa Barbara Winery. He now oversees every facet of the estate as Managing Director.

Over the past 40 years, our family has been honored to play a significant role in establishing the Dundee Hills as a premier viticultural region. We farm the land with the care it deserves to grow and craft the truest expression of the varietals we farm; creating wines with balance, structure and texture. We have continued to hone our style, taking care to never impose on the vineyards or wines they produce.

The original 30-acre parcel has since expanded to encompass three estate vineyards totaling more than 70-acres under vine. Our winery facility and tasting room sits at the crown of the estate, featuring stunning panoramic views of vineyards, rolling valleys, and snowcapped Mt. Hood and Mt. Jefferson. In early 2022, we acquired a 65-acre property with 30 acres planted to pinot noir, near Monmouth, Oregon. We renamed the vineyard to Lucky River Vineyard, a nod to the Luckiamute River which runs just south of the property.

The core of our farming and production practices is centered around sustainability and ensuring the health of the land for generations to come. Our vineyards are certified L.I.V.E and Salmon Safe. We bottle our wines in recycled, locally sourced glass to reduce our carbon footprint, and rely on solar for a significant portion of our energy needs.

Our wines have garnered serious praise from critics over the years, most recently 94 points and 'Cellar Selection' from Wine Enthusiast for our 2023 Estate Vineyard Pinot Noir, and 96 points from Decanter for our 2023 Freedom Hill Vineyard Pinot Noir. Our wines are bright and fruit forward upon release, with the longevity for cellaring.

The world's best wines reflect both the character of the remarkable vineyards they come from and the people who make them. Combining decades of skill, artistry and vision, our family is dedicated to making exceptional wines from our estate and a handful of Oregon's most iconic vineyards. To this day, our mission remains true to our roots, and so do our wines.
